Conflict Minerals, Conflict Metals, Dodd-Frank Act,

Dear Sir or Madam,

We confirm that we purchase our metal and metal containing minerals from approved suppliers only. In the course of this approval, Galvano Hengelo is exercising its due diligence in analyzing its supply chain to assure that metals procured from its suppliers are not "Conflict Metals". A "Conflict Metal" is metal derived or sourced from mines in conflict areas of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), or illegally taxed on trade routes, either which is controlled by non-government military groups, or unlawful military fractions. Trade routes not confirmed to be "Conflict Free" include direct exports from the DRC, as well as exports through Rwanda, Uganda, Burundi, Tanzania and Kenya (countries of whom the U.N. Security Council note are global export routes for DRC-mined minerals).

Galvano Hengelo procures just tin and gold minerals as potential conflict minerals. However, our suppliers of these minerals provided us with "DRC Conflict Free" statements. Without having evaluated whether or not our products supplied to your company contain any tin or gold minerals at all, we generally confirm our products to be "Conflict Free".
